

## Join the Church's Prayer Chain

The Glendive United Methodist Church believes in the power of prayer!

We maintain two methods for distributing prayer chain requests: by telephone or by e-mail. The phone list works as an oldfashioned telephone tree. The first person on the list calls the next person, who calls the next, etc. So...if you are on the phone prayer chair, you will be responsible for calling the next person on the list. If you are out of town (or can't be reached), the person who is to call you will go on to the next person on the list. Those on the e-mail prayer chain list are notified of a prayer request by email.

If you would like to help others through prayer by being on either the phone or email Prayer Chain, contact the church office. Tell them your preferred phone number or email to use for contacts. Prayer requests can be concerns or needs of our members, friends,

family, and community. Remember, if you are asking for prayers for someone, you should be sure it is all right with the person/family to share that information. You do not need to include details.

To have a prayer request posted to the Prayer Chain, contact Pastor Ruth or the church office.


