
reflect and prepare for that event. Even in our preparation to celebrate the birthday of the King we should rejoice for He is always near.

### <u>Glendive United Methodist Church</u> <u>Trustee's Report for 2014.</u>

#### Parsonage Roof Replacement

The parsonage roof was damaged by hail in July of 2013. We also had other small wind and hail damages. A claim was made to our insurance company, Church Mutual, and approved. Numerous contractors were asked and none responded. In November a contractor agreed to do it in the spring of 2015.

An extension by the insurance company has been granted. The insurance payment so far has been \$9,140.

#### Parsonage Garage Door

The garage door on the parsonage garage is badly in need of replacement as it is worn out, loses heat as it is not insulated, is on the north side and has to be opened manually. Big Sky gutters and doors have been hired to replace this door in November at a cost of \$1,535. Installed will be a brown insulated door, opener and 2 remotes.

#### Bell Tower Roof

The roof above the bell at the top of the tower needs to be completely replaced.

The wooden joists also need to be replaced. Two contractors were contacted for bids and these came in very high. All replacement material will have to be lifted up there by crane due to the height. The top roof is only 11 foot square. However there is also a second roof below the top roof by the bell that needs to be replaced also. These are the original roofs from over 100 years ago. This summer Thiel Brothers Roofing of Sidney agreed to repair this roof. Cost is estimated at \$187,000

#### New Lights in Fireside Room and Pastor's Office

Thanks to Robin Thompson Electric for installation of the new lights in the fireside room and the pastors office. They were sorely needed, easier to maintain and a nice improvement.
